Should not a religion be judged according to whether it helps the personal lives of its followers to be changed for the better? Is it time to stop making excuses for the religion but to study it honestly for what it is?

Is the Malay mindset and worldview (which is much dominated by Islam) progressive and respected abroad? Or is it a narrow and regressive one that is heard loudly in this country only because the Malays are the dominant race in the country? Does the on-going controversy on the use of the word "Allah" speak of a progressive mindset/world view? Or the laughing stock of the world? Is the protectionist policy like that of seizing children Christian books off the shelves of bookstores and seizing Christian books at Customs

progressive? Does a progressive mindset embrace double standards in every area of its life? Does a progressive mind view those of other faith as inferior? Does a progressive mindset discriminate against people based on their race and faith? Does the progressive mindset fear challenges?
